



# SACDS GIVES BACK

SACDS is coordinating a PPE supplies drive for Washington Hospital, Valley Care Medical, and Eden Medical in the wake of Covid19. Local hospitals are suffering from a shortage of personal protective equipment. As part of the healthcare community, it's important that we aid front-line workers so that they can continue to aid the sick. Protecting those that are directly dealing with the outbreak is vitally important and a way to help reduce the health risks to all our extended friends and families. If your closed office has PPE to spare currently, we ask you to consider donating.

Here's a list of the items being asked for and associated specifications. The only items that need to be exactly as specified are the N95s, because of fit testing. Everything else can be substituted with like items, as long as they are FDA approved.

1. N95 – we use three. The 1860s are very much in need right now.
  - a. 3M 1870 OR 1870+
  - b. 3M 1860
  - c. 3M 1860S
2. Procedure Mask
  - a. We use Halyard 47107 and 4147 but will take anything that is labeled as fluid resistant
3. Surgical Mask – we use:
  - a. Halyard 42049215, 42048100, 42062113, 42048220 but will take anything you might have.
4. Isolation Gowns
  - a. We use Medline NON27236
  - b. We will take whatever they have, especially larger sizes.
5. Gloves – we use Nitrile Exam Gloves
  - a. Medline MDS2501, MDS2502, MDS2503 but will take any Nitrile exam glove
6. Sanitizing Wipes – we use alcohol and bleach based wipes. The Alcohol wipe is more widely used and in greater demand. That said, equivalencies are fine.
  - a. PDI Sani Cloth Q55172 - Alcohol based
  - b. PDI Sani Cloth P54072 – Bleach
7. All other PPE
  - a. Bouffant Caps – any
  - b. Shoe covers – any
8. Closed suction catheter for ventilator
  - a. Halyard 2210 TRACH CARE DOUBLE SWIBEL ELBOW 14FR or any equivalent. I can review with RT if these are on the table.
